1. Passengers are not allowed to enter until 31 December 2020.

This does not apply to:

- nationals and residents of Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czechia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Ireland (Rep.), Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden, Switzerland and United Kingdom;
- residents of Andorra, Australia, Japan, Korea (Rep.), Monaco, New Zealand, Rwanda, San Marino, Singapore, Thailand, Uruguay or Vatican City (Holy See);
- passengers arriving from Austria, Belgium, Bulgaria, Croatia, Cyprus, Czechia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Romania, Slovakia, Slovenia, Sweden, Switzerland or United Kingdom;
- passengers with a long-term visa issued by a Schengen Member State returning via Spain to their country of residence;
- passengers with a diplomatic passport traveling on duty;
- merchant seamen;
- military personnel;
- immediate family members of a national of an EU Member State traveling together or traveling to join the national of an EU Member State;
- immediate family members of a British national traveling together or traveling to join the British national;

- passengers who are unmarried partners of nationals of Spain. They must have a confirmation of their relationship issued by a consulate of Spain;
- students with proof of being enrolled in a course in Austria, Belgium, Czechia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, Germany, Greece, Hungary, Iceland, Italy, Latvia, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain, Sweden or Switzerland. They must:
 - have a medical insurance; and
 - be traveling to the country where they study, at most 15 days before the start of the course.

2. Passengers arriving from Albania, Andorra, Argentina, Armenia, Austria, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Belgium, Belize, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Cape Verde, Colombia, Costa Rica, Croatia, Curacao, Cyprus, Czechia, Denmark, Estonia, France, French Polynesia, Georgia, Germany, Gibraltar, Greece, Guam, Hungary, Iceland, Iran, Ireland (Rep.), Italy, Jordan, Kuwait, Latvia, Lebanon, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Moldova (Rep.), Monaco, Montenegro, Morocco, Netherlands, North Macedonia (Rep.), Norway, Palestinian Territory, Panama, Poland, Portugal, Puerto Rico, Romania, Russian Fed., San Marino, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, St. Maarten, Sweden, Switzerland, USA, Ukraine, United Arab Emirates or United Kingdom must have a medical certificate with a negative Coronavirus (COVID-19) RT-PCR or TMA test result. The test must have been taken at most 72 hours before arrival and the certificate must be in English or Spanish.

- This does not apply to passengers arriving from Agder, Innlandet, More og Romsdal, Nordland, Rogaland, Troms og Finnmark, Trøndelag and Vestfold og Telemark in Norway; arriving from Notio Aigaio in Greece; or arriving from Faroe Isl. or Greenland.

- This does not apply to passengers younger than 6 years.

3. Passengers must complete an "FCS Health Control Form" at <https://www.spth.gob.es/> . A QR code generated from the completed form must be presented upon arrival.

4. Residency permits and "D" visas issued by Spain that expired between 17 December 2019 and 21 June 2020 are accepted for entry until 21 December 2020.

5. Passengers are subject to medical screening upon arrival.

Effective 14 December 2020:

Passengers arriving from Albania, Andorra, Argentina, Armenia, Aruba, Austria, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Belgium, Belize, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, Cape Verde, Colombia, Costa Rica, Croatia, Curacao, Cyprus, Czechia, Denmark, Estonia, Finland, France, French Polynesia, Georgia, Germany, Gibraltar, Greece, Guam, Hungary, Iran, Italy, Jordan, Latvia, Lebanon, Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Malta, Moldova (Rep.), Montenegro, Morocco, Netherlands, North Macedonia (Rep.), Norway, Palestinian Territory, Panama, Poland, Portugal, Puerto Rico, Romania, Russian Fed., San Marino, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, St. Maarten, Sweden, Switzerland, USA, Ukraine, United Arab Emirates or United Kingdom must have a medical certificate with a negative Coronavirus (COVID-19) RT - PCR or TMA test result. The test must have been taken at most 72 hours before arrival and the certificate must be in English or Spanish.

- This does not apply to passengers arriving from

Agder, Innlandet, Møre og Romsdal, Nordland, Rogaland, Troms og Finnmark, Trøndelag, Vestfold og Telemark and Vestland in Norway; arriving from Etela-Suomi, Lansi-Suomi, Pohjois-Ja Ita-Suomi and Aland in Finland, arriving from Faroe Isl., Greenland or Nordjylland in Denmark or arriving from Guadalupe in France.

- This does not apply to passengers younger than 6 years.
